

Moka City is about a two-hour drive from Tokyo or about an hour-and-a-half train ride on a Shinkansen and local train. Located in the southeastern part of Tochigi Prefecture, it is a city of bountiful nature featuring the Yamizo Mountains in the east and the grand Kinugawa River running in the west. Moka City is an industrial city developed as a home to a large number of companies.

Within Tochigi Prefecture, Moka City has the highest percentage of foreign residents, making it a culturally diverse city. It is focusing its efforts on the development of human resources with global competency. For example, all junior high schools in the city engage in exchange activities such as mutual student visits with overseas schools. Such initiatives are rare for Japan.

The city has also entered sister and friendship city agreements with three cities to foster understanding of diverse cultures and values and to contribute to regional development through international exchanges.

# BECOME THE BRIDGE BETWEEN MOKA CITY AND THREE FRIENDSHIP CITIES!

### City of Glendora, USA

Moka City and the City of Glendora entered a sister city agreement in 1988, and their exchanges have been continuing for a long time since then. Exchanges began first in the area of music and have expanded into the area of education. Citizen these cities are deepening their ties through these exchanges.

#### Shire of Harvey, Australia

Moka City signed a friendship city agreement with Shire of Harvey in 2022. They have been actively engaging in exchanges between sister schools as well as between other elementary and senior high schools. Their relationship has been solidified through online signing ceremonies and commemoration events.

#### Douliu City, Taiwan

Exchanges between Douliu City and Moka City began in the private sector. They have since then continued and expanded their exchanges, deepened mutual understanding and friendship. In 2023, the two cities signed a friendship city agreement. Citizen-level exchanges are also active. To promote cross-cultural understanding, exchanges include visiting each other's city.

Through exchanges with these cities, Moka City is working to widen citizens' international perspective and deepen their cross-cultural understanding. Your task as International Exchange Coordinators is to support and further expand these exchange activities.

About Moka City

Moka City is in the southeastern part of Tochigi Prefecture. It is a city of bountiful nature featuring the Yamizo mountains in the east and the grand Kinugawa River running in the west.

It is within 100 kilometers of Tokyo, and it takes about 1 hour and 40 minutes from Tokyo by the Tohoku Shinkansen.

The city has an area of 167.34 km2 and population of about 78,000. It is an ideal regional city with a good balance of agriculture, industry, and commerce where urban planning, industrial park development, and farmland improvement have achieved good progress.

Strawberries are the city's specialty. The city boasts the largest strawberry production in the "Strawberry Kingdom Tochigi". It has been a regular recipient of the Minister of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries Prize. During the strawberry season, which runs through winter and spring, the city welcomes many visitors who come for fresh strawberry picking.
